The Indianapolis Artsgarden is located over the intersection of Illinois and Washington Streets in downtown Indianapolis. Parking for this venue may be found in parking garages for Circle Center Mall or along the street. Street parking is free on the weekends. Note: The Indianapolis Colts are not playing this weekend and the Pacers do not have a game scheduled for October 18. No major events are taking place that day, so parking should be readily available.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION:

Please arrive, unpack your instrument, and begin warming up **prior to** 5:15 pm. We plan to begin the dress rehearsal at 5:15 pm. We realize that some members may be a little late due to siblings rehearsing at Butler in other ensembles.

You will not need to bring a music stand – they will be provided for everyone.

CONCERT ATTIRE:

Please arrive at the Artsgarden in concert attire.

Concert attire for boys is black pants, black dress shoes, black dress socks, and a white shirt. The shirt should be a collared shirt either a polo or button-up shirt. No T-shirts, shorts, athletic shoes, or flip-flops.

Concert attire for girls is black pants or skirt, black dress shoes, black socks (if appropriate), and a white shirt. The shirt should be a blouse, polo, or button-up shirt. Skirts should be knee length or longer. No T-shirts, shorts, athletic shoes, flip-flops, or tank-tops.

CELLO/BASS SECTIONS:

Plan to bring a rock stop or any other items needed to perform on a slick surface.

AFTER THE CONCERT:

Please remain seated following applause of the last piece. We will pass out new music for the December 13 performance.
